



### **Policy 8: Smoking at the Northern Virginia Center**

According to Virginia Tech Policy 1010 3.1:

*Employees who smoke outside of buildings are expected to be considerate and courteous of other individuals in the university community. Smoking locations should not impede traffic flow in or out of buildings and should be in a location where smoke cannot drift into office or class space. Additionally, employees are asked to leave the smoking locations free of cigarette butts and other trash materials. All faculty, staff, and students share the responsibility of keeping the campus clean, attractive, and litter-free.*

The University of Virginia's Policy SEC 028 states that:

*Smoking is prohibited inside facilities owned or leased by the University and in University-owned vehicles, except as noted below. It is also prohibited (1) within 25 feet of all entries, outdoor air intakes, and operable windows; and (2) in any outside area adjacent to a facility whose configuration and/or other physical conditions allow smoke either to enter and affect the internal environment or to unduly affect the environment of those entering or exiting the facility.*

The Virginia Tech/University of Virginia Northern Virginia Center prohibits smoking inside the building, including the double-door entrances, and within 25 feet of all entries and outdoor air intakes.
